

## **First Peoples' Assembly of Victoria – Youth Voice naming call-out**

### **Conditions of entry**

From time to time the First Peoples' Assembly runs promotional give aways and competitions.

At 5pm Thursday 27 October 2022 we are running a public call-out competition for young people (aged 12-28) to submit ideas for a name for the Assembly's soon to be established Youth Voice. Submissions must be a word or words in an Aboriginal language of Victoria, along with the translation. Those entering are encouraged to propose a name that reflects the principles and pillars of the Youth Voice. Submissions will be open for 8 days and will close at 5pm, Friday 4 November 2022.

The winner of the lottery will receive prizes in accordance with the terms and conditions below, and the Assembly will separately determine the name to be given to the Youth Voice.

Entry into this lottery is deemed to be acceptance of the conditions of entry and consent to the Assembly's use, storage and disclosure of your personal information as set out below. You can read our privacy policy here for information about why and how we keep records of some of your personal details – for example, we ask for your email address so we can contact you to notify you if you've won the prizes.

### **Conditions of entry**

This lottery is run by the First Peoples' Assembly of Victoria Ltd (ABN 51 636 189 412) (Assembly, we, us or our) of 48 Cambridge Street, Collingwood, Victoria 3066.

#### **1. General conditions**

- 1.1. Entry is free and open to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people living in the State of Victoria, or Traditional Owners of Country in Victoria living interstate, who are aged between 12 and 28 at the time of entry.
- 1.2. Entrants under the age of 18 must have their parent or legal guardian's consent to enter the competition.
- 1.3. Entry into this lottery is deemed acceptance of conditions of entry.
- 1.4. Entry into this lottery is through filling out an online form located on the Assembly's website.
- 1.5. One entry is permitted per person.
- 1.6. Employees of the Assembly are ineligible to participate.
- 1.7. Entry to the lottery will open from 5pm Thursday 27 October 2022 and will conclude at 5pm Friday 4 November 2022.
- 1.8. Entries must include a word or words in an Aboriginal language of Victoria, and the English translation, that the Assembly's soon to be established Youth Voice could be named after.

#### **2. Lottery draw**

- 2.1. The lottery draw will determine one winner of the prize pack in clause 2.3 but does not determine the name of the Youth Voice. The Youth Voice name will be determined in accordance with clause 5 below.
- 2.2. The draw for the winner will take place after 5pm on Friday 4 November 2022. Entrants need not be present to win.

- 2.3. The prize pack contains the following prizes: a double pass to the First & Forever music festival, a \$100 Haus of Dizzy voucher, an Indigenous AFL guernsey of choice and a selection of Assembly merchandise.
  - 2.4. Each entrant will be assigned a number, which will be drawn at random through government certified electronic draw system [www.random draws.com.au](http://www.randomdraws.com.au) provided by the business Trade Promotion and Lotteries Pty Ltd (ACN 601 297 330) (TPAL Electronic Draw System).
3. Winning entry
  - 3.1. The winner of the lottery draw will need to show proof of identification before the prizes are released.
  - 3.2. The winner of the lottery draw will be notified via email no later than Thursday 10 November 2022 and their name will be published on the Assembly's website.
  - 3.3. The prizes cannot be transferred or redeemed for cash unless deemed faulty.
4. Collection of prizes
  - 4.1. The prizes will be delivered to the winner within 28 days after the winner is declared. The Assembly will make all reasonable efforts to locate the winner and deliver the prizes.
  - 4.2. If the Assembly is unable to locate a winner and deliver the prize after reasonable efforts have been made to identify the winner, the winner may be substituted via a second draw.
5. Choosing a Youth Voice name
  - 5.1. Naming of the Youth Voice will not be determined in accordance with the lottery process.
  - 5.2. The Final decision on the name of the Youth Voice will be made by the First Peoples' Assembly of Victoria after appropriate approvals are given in line with cultural protocols.
  - 5.3. The Assembly reserves the right to not choose a name for the Youth Voice from the entries submitted.
  - 5.4. If the Assembly selects a name for the Youth Voice from the entries submitted, the individual who submitted this name will be contacted and acknowledged.
6. Privacy consent statement
  - 6.1. We will collect, use, store and disclose your personal information provided to us in your survey for the purpose of conducting this lottery (including entering your name into the TPAL Electronic Draw System).
  - 6.2. You may request access to any personal information that we have collected about you, including correction of your personal information if you can establish that it is not accurate, complete or up to date, using the contact details in our Privacy Policy found at [www.firstpeoplesvic.org/privacystatement](http://www.firstpeoplesvic.org/privacystatement) or as required by law. Our Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store and disclose your personal information and how you can access and seek correction of it or make a complaint.
